Abstract: The presence of Covid-19 has caused resistance from the religious community resulting in violations of health protocols during the pandemic. This study aims to explain the resistance of the religious community to the application of health protocols in the implementation of religious activities. Data collection was carried out by observation and interviews taken from the area around Demak, Central Java, Indonesia, as well as from literature review related to this study. The resistance concept approach is used, then analyzed in a descriptive and qualitative methods. The results of this study indicate that there are four forms of resistance from Muslim groups to Covid-19 pandemic, namely in places of worship, social activities, traditional routines and religious leaders. Meanwhile, the resistance factor is more likely to be influenced by the factors of fatalistic theology, textual Islamic jurisprudence (fiqh) and escapist Sufism which have created a passive

religious attitude in responding to the problem of Covid-19 countermeasures. In addition, local Islamic religious leaders (kyai deso) had a strong influence in forming resistance. Thus, the study shows that there is a relationship that is not synergistic and harmonious both in religious thought and practice between religious organizations at the central level and the lower-class society. The study suggests the need for cooperation between the government and religious devotees to deconstruct the less responsive religious discourses toward Covid-19 countermeasures. This was done by involving traditional religious leaders (kyai deso) in the Covid-19 countermeasures.
