Reviewer #1: The manuscript presents a very original and interesting topic, which is not yet investigated in psychology: exploring the meanings and the suffering associated with deformities of physical organs in fingers and/or toes from birth. The topic fits very well with journal scope and I recommend to accept it, after some improvements that I am listing below: 1) the manuscript is in a good initial condition, however, some passages are too illustrative, using a language of textbook. For instance, the section Theoretical Perspective, some statements like "Quantitative-statistical research is different from "qualitative" research". The same in the methodological section. These passages can be cut off, stressing more the author's own perspective

2) I suggest to take of the visible face of the person in figure 1 for reasons of privacy.

3) in a qualitative phenomenological research, one cannot talk about "subjects", so in general the terminology must be made consistent with the theoretical framework.

4) names of participants are fictitious?

5) how long the observation have lasted?

6) what is the researcher's position/background with respect to the community of participants?

- 7) I wonder if the author can explore also the ambivalences of meaning
- 8) I suggest to expand the conclusions, what is the real theoretical advancement proposed by the author?

Reviewer #2: Dear author

Thank you for an interesting paper. The values of the work are dealing with physical disabilities that IPBS have not published, the abnormal organ in developing countries, and mild impairment. However, I ask you to reduce repetitive theoretical introduction, clarification of data collection and analysis, reorganize the results, including the development of the 4 pictures, and revision of the conclusion with theoretical consideration. I strongly consider that the current manuscript would contribute to our journal with the necessary revision. I hope that my comments are of help to prepare it for publication.

Request and suggestion

1. Reconsider "suffering" and "suffer." Currently, these words are offensive and avoided in disability research. For example, they should be changed into "people with oligodactyly" "people sustaining oligodactyly"? I recommend you to review journals dealing with disabilities in social sciences.
2. Introduction. I understand that referral to people with oligodactyly and their discriminative experience is required. You, however, can reduce some repetitive descriptions, and some of them are duplicate with the following section. The significant revisions are regarding a brief description of the impairment, their difficult circumstances, social background, including disability policy. First, "There are no private companies that accept employees" seems to be overstated. You need citations on disability employment. Second, you can move the description of disability policy and law in the country into the present section from the following one (p.3, Oligodactyly Suffering). Third, you can reduce sentences on their hardships.
3. Conceptual Scope, Theoretical, and Methodological Consideration. This section should be shortened. You can combine self-meaning and theoretical perspective, mention the requirement of qualitative study at the first part of the section, and explain your theoretical position, including self-meaning. Each paragraph is just listed and partly duplicated. You can drop the first paragraph of Methodological Consideration or move the only essence into the previous section.
4. Methodological Consideration. Please kindly explain your recruitment method of research participants. What item did you use at your in-depth interviews? The data analysis procedure is unclear. I ask you to mention analysis steps such as coding, combining the codes, and developing categories. You need some citations on the data analysis method.
5. Physical Abnormalities of the Self-Meaning Oligodactyly Suffering. I can follow their experiences in this section. However, it is difficult for me to find connections of some categories, and trace proceedings of the pictures. Can you drop "of the Self-Meaning" in headings, which is self-obvious? The grammatical relationship is unclear. The following sentences are grammatically unclear. These are some rhetoric? Even though English is not my mother tongue, I consider that these sentences should be simplified.

P6, LL.37-43.

"Live life by doing self-introspection and not being silent, not as a hindrance to life, the spirit of life, helping family activities. People with oligodactyly suffering illustrate, the spirit of life never gives up. Give the spirit of life never give up in trying to do himself and accept his condition as an individual who must live their daily lives. Do not feel weak and assume physical abnormalities experienced are not obstacles in life. Believe, Allah gives trials according to ability."

P.8, LL.22-23.

"Negative thoughts and assume others will insult and ridicule themselves when interacting."

6. Pictures and main texts. If possible, I ask you to elaborate on the meaning of the arrows or lines in each picture. "The" (Self-Meaning of...) were dropped in pictures 1 and 2. Do you intentionally do it? I am not able to find "Introvert" in picture 2 in the headings. Is it "Socially Withdrawn of the Self-Meaning"? I ask you to elaborate sequence of blue categories in picture 3. "Socially" is coming from "Introvert" in the picture "? Can you change "picture" into "figure"?
7. The Self-Meaning of the Physical Organ Forms Oligodactyly Suffering and picture 4. Would you elaborate on how you get picture 4 from other pictures such as picture 3?
Reading the main-text, I am not able to process of developing the final pictures clearly. I am also wondering about the relationship between "Finger and Toes" and "Physical Organs." It seemed that you use both words interchangeably as they have a similar meaning. However, it might have unique connections in their self-meaning. I consider that this might be related to the development of the final pictures.
8. Even though I understand the limitation of the manuscript length, I ask you to discuss the final results from the following points.

-the age or generation

-the severity of the current impairment. I suppose that the impairment does not cause severe difficulties to ADL. We can say it "mild impairment."
-the socio-cultural perspective of Indonesia or Asia.

Again, I appreciate an excellent opportunity to review insightful manuscripts. I hope that you will rewrite it with my comments. Thank you.

Besides, pictures showing the face of children are not acceptable and must be either removed or anonymized by covering the face. Until the ethical issues are not solved, the article cannot be accepted
