The authors have provided a rationale of study with appropriate reference to the literature. However, the gaps of the study should be clearly addressed and drawn to the research questions.
- The theoretical framework is unclearly addressed. The authors should synthesize, criticize and argued issues related to conceptual change text and bring to the conceptual framework.
- The methodology is well-explained. The methodology should provide an appropriate approach with suitable framework for data analysis. Evidences are should clearly provided.
- The findings should be separated from discussion. The authors should give specific examples of interview answers or other qualitative data.
- The contributions of this study should be clearly discussed. The researchers should compare the findings to other research and make arguments in terms of new knowledge.


